James A. House... aka "House," was born in Greenville, Mississippi, November 7, 1962. He moved to Las Vegas, Nevada with his parents in the summer of 1978. After graduating high school, he enlisted in the U.S. Army and served three years with the 82nd Airborne Division. After serving, he returned to Las Vegas and attended The Lenz Talent Agency where he studied acting and commercials training. After graduating, he performed in several shows throughout the Las Vegas area including films such as "**Heat**" with Burt Reynolds and "**Over the Top**" with Sylvester Stallone and stage plays such as "**You Can't Take It With You**" and "**This and That.**" James went on to study with Mr. Jack Bell and Sly Ali Smith of The Las Vegas Little Theater and performed in "**A Soldiers Play**" and "**No Place to Be Somebody.**" He studied with Mr. Joe Behar of (UNLV) The University of Nevada Las Vegas and performed in such plays as "**A Few Good Men**" and "**Raisin In the Sun.**" James reenlisted in the Army, October 1986 and met Artistic Director Eric Shepard of Vive Le Arts Theater in Killeen, Texas, and was asked to serve as Assistant Director in "**The Buddy Holly Story**" and "**Dark at the Top of the Stairs.** While in Texas, James attended and Graduated from Central Texas College and founded his 501 (c) (3) Non-Profit organization called **H.O.U.S.E. Theatre Arts Group.** His organization works with underprivileged children in the Killeen and the surrounding area. After serving 20 years, James retired from the U.S. Army and currently resides in Cary, North Carolina. He has also opened his organization in Cary, where he is currently working with underprivileged children in the Triangle area. James has appeared in several commercials and was the lead in an Independent film titled "**The Watchmen**" Since relocating to North Carolina, January 2005, he has appeared in and served as Assistant Director on Independent films such as "**Divine Intervention**" and "**TAG.**" He has Directed or served as Stage Manager in such Stage plays as "**Butterfly Wings,**" "**Strong Woman**", "**Lord, Why am I Still Single**" "**A Man Sensitive To A Woman's Needs**", **The Armistad Saga**, and the hit Comedy "**Hell of A Situation.**" In addition, James has directed four **Gospel** and two **Hip-Hop Music Videos.** He has worked with such artist as Comedian J.
