Contemporary Gospel Artist Tracy Worth, of Chicago, Illinois, dubbed “*the sweet voice of Gospel Music*” is, stepping out in the vast frontier of gospel music with her own creativity and style by embracing a variety of musical influences while adding her own unique flavor. Armed with her signature angelic vocals and melodic storytelling, Tracy delivers an infused blend of Contemporary Gospel, Inspirational, and Christian music with influences of Gospel, Soul, Jazz and Pop. Her inspiring songs have earned Tracy the distinction of being signed as spokesperson to “*Habitat for Humanity International Faith Works/Women Build Initiatives.*”

To that end, “*Don’t Let Heaven Pass You By*” is more than the title of her *Serenity Entertainment* debut. While “*Don’t Let Heaven Pass You By*” and “*I’ll Follow You*” – the latter featuring a sensational duet with gospel veteran Melvin Williams – are the standout selections, Tracy really demonstrates her vocal flexibility on “*Your Love*” says Bob Marovich in a review for “*The Gospel Highway.*” Other stirring selections include “*Hem of His Garment*”, “*What He Does Best*”, “*Walkin’ By Faith*” and “*Be Still*” -- some of radio’s favorites.

Tracy’s production team is a creative consortium that spans the realm of music itself. At one end are the familiar raspy vocals of Melvin Williams on “*I’ll Follow You*”, on the other, producer, Ronald Walters, Jr., who was a guest music director during the 2004 American Idol season. His resume spans from the great Barry Manilow to American Idol Contestants George Huff and Kimberly Locke, to Gospel producer, Bobby Wooten. Richard Gibbs, son of Caravans’, Inez Andrews and Terry Yancy, brother of the late Marvin Yancy penned “*You Knew Me*” that hit #1 on XM Satellite Radio with over 2 million listeners.

Tracy is sharing her music with a variety of audiences with appearances on TBN’s “*Praise the Lord*”, Hollywood Gospel Insider Award Show, Nashville’s GMA Week, the Shirley Caesar Conference, several Bobby Jones television programs including Gospel Explosion, International Gospel Artist Retreat and most recently, BET’s 2005 Bobby Jones Gospel Hour. At the Gospel Music Workshop of America (GMWA) with an annual attendance of over 30,000 attendees, Tracy opened with an *acapella* rendition of the classic “*I Have Decided to Follow Jesus*” that quickly transformed to her contemporary hit “*I’ll Follow You*” at the “*Tribute to James Cleveland*” Concert and Youth Showcase hosted by Kirk Franklin. Most recently Tracy performed at Dr. Bobby Cartwright’s Gospel Superfest, USA in Brooklyn, NY televised on CBS and syndicated Radio One’s WPZE Atlanta’s Anniversary Celebration.

Tracy’s music videos “*I’ll Follow You*” and “*What He Does Best*” airs on BET Video Gospel, the WORD Network, MBC, TBN, Eastman Curtis and BroSteve TV plus of host of regional programs that include Billy Carson’s Gospel City Videos (IL), Evangeline Bullock’s SHINE (NC) and Donovan Hartwell’s Gospel Showcase (IN).
